- ✓ This week's attendance for EYFS and Key Stage 1 was 87.7% and for Key Stage 2 it was 93.6%.
- ✓ We are busy preparing for Christmas. Foundation Stage rehearsals are in full swing and they are looking forward to their performances next week. We're also busy learning the songs for our carol service at St Mary's Church and the Year 6 postal elves were very busy today sorting and delivering the Christmas cards.
- ✓ It was lovely to see so many families at the recent Year 6 SATs meeting. - ✓ On Wednesday **Year 1** pupils took their learning over to the Nature Discovery Centre. They used a tens frame and natural resources to represent 8. "8 is made of 5 and 3, 5 and 3 make 8" were the stem sentences they practised. They also found a rather large scorpion like beetle and hunted for primary and secondary colours.
- ✓ We've been notified by the Nature Discovery Centre that the Park and Stride car park will be shut in January. Sadly, ash trees at the Nature Discovery Centre have been affected by ash dieback. They need to carry out essential tree felling work this winter.
