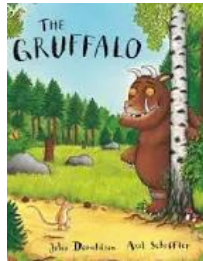
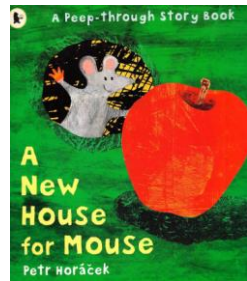
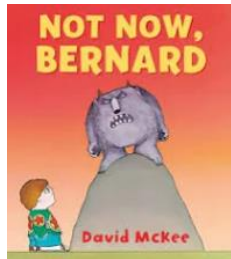

Please check to see when it is your child's 'Be the Teacher'. Remember to send a sun hat to school with your child.

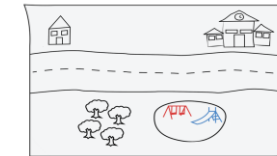
Don't forget Sports Day on Wednesday 26th June – there is no Wellie Wednesday, Please send your child into school wearing their P.E. kit.

In maths we this week we have continued to use words to describe the position of something. We have also created our own maps based on the stories of Little Red Riding hood and The Gruffalo.



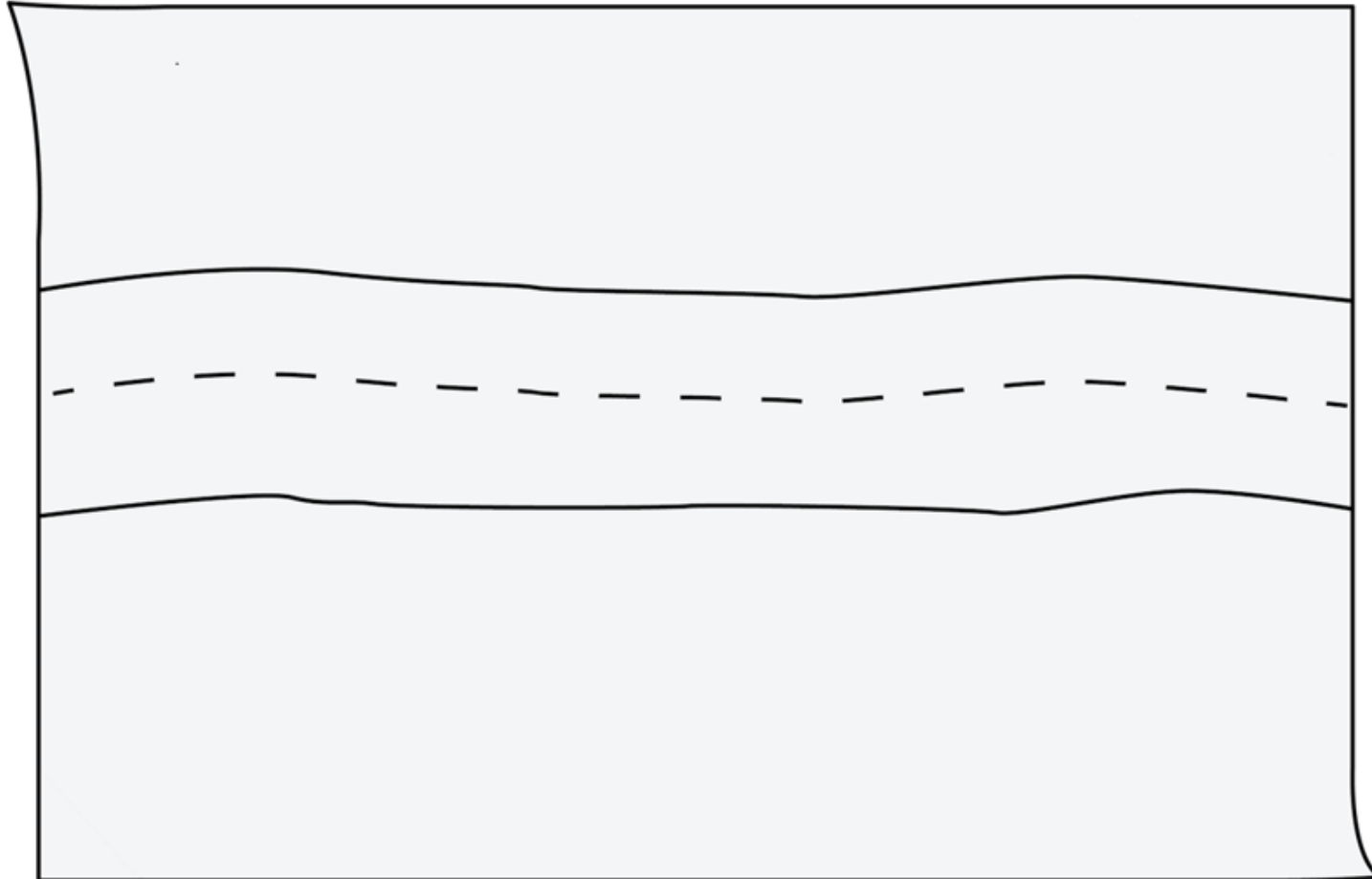
Understanding the World
