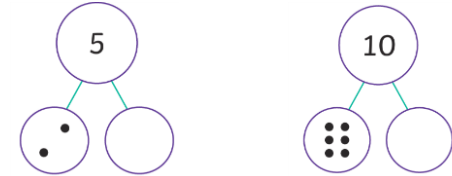
Please check to see when it is your child's 'Be the Teacher'. Remember to send a sun hat to school with your child. Don't forget Sports Day on Tuesday 9th July

In maths we have been looking at the part part whole model and the children have used it to solve number problems. We have also been practicing number bonds to five and using this knowledge to solve problems.

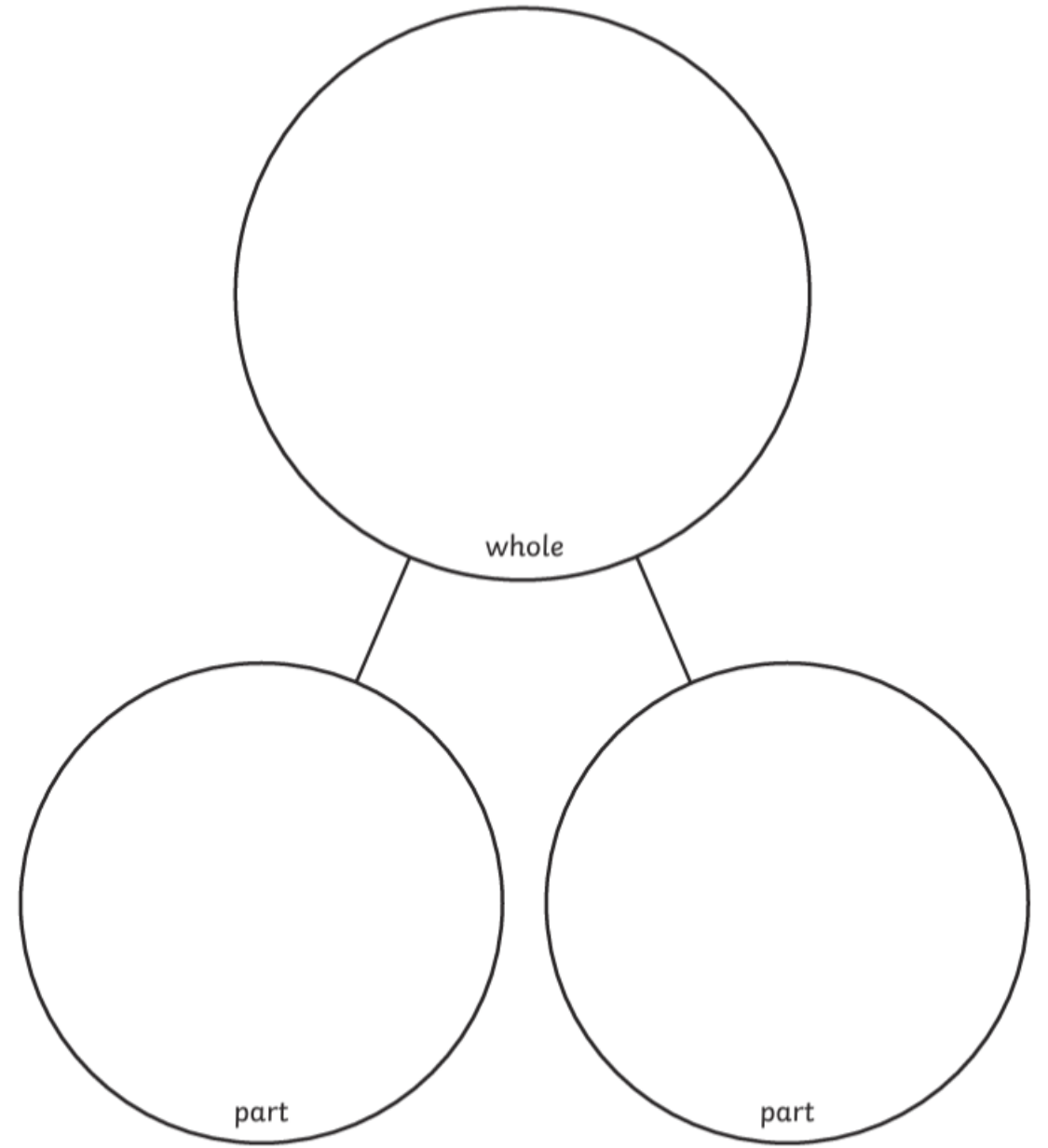
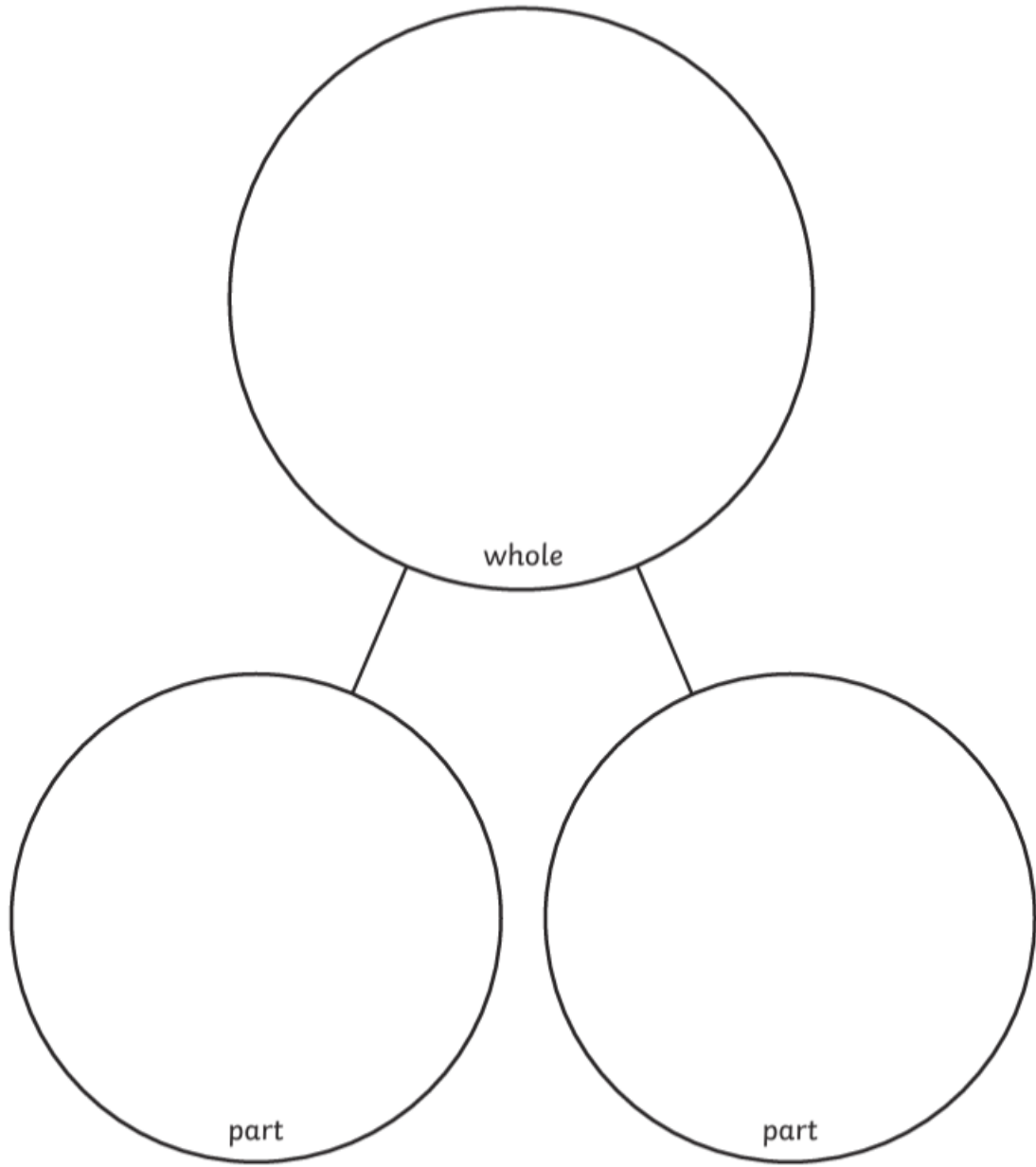


Understanding the World
