- ✓ This week's **attendance** for EYFS and Key Stage 1 was 91.7% and for Key Stage 2 it was 94.2%.

- ✓ This half term we're focussing on keeping ourselves safe in PSHE. I launched the theme last week and this week we had a routine fire drill. The children were brilliant.
