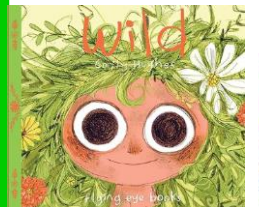
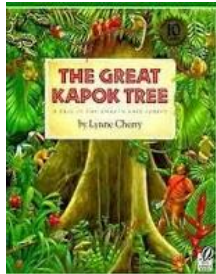
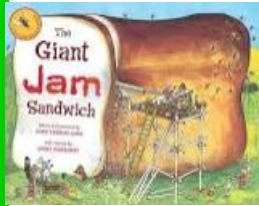

Literacy

In drawing club this week our story was 'The Giant Jam Sandwich'. The children drew wasps flying around the town of Itching Down. Later they went on to think of another way to trap the wasps. Ideas ranged from jelly, fruit juices to pizza's! The children then designed different ways of getting the bread to the field.

In phonics we have been practicing holding a sentence as well as polysyllabic words and tricky words.

At home you could try:

- Reading with your child.
- Spotting the position of different objects and describing it using words such as behind, in front, above, under, next to, between etc.
- Practise reading and spelling the tricky words attached.
