

<u>Literacy</u>

Our focus story this week was The Pea and the Princess. We thought of our own sentences related to the story and what a character was doing. In drawing club we drew one of the characters and then later in the week we invented a new way for the princess to get down from a bed of twenty mattresses. New vocabulary included; velvety, important, pestering, immediately, glum, properly, furious and desperately. In phonics this week we have learnt the last few sounds in phase 2: h, b, f, ff, l, ll and ss. We will now be consolidating our knowledge and working on blending and segmenting skills.

At home you could try:

- Setting up a picnic with toys and finding an equal amount of accessories for them e.g. 3 toys with 3, plates, cups, spoons etc – how do they know they have enough things?
- Reading the words attached and spotting sounds when out and about.
- Practicing forming the letters shapes
- Practicing doing the zip up on their coat




