Spelling activities and games online to practice:

Clueless Crossword - This quick and fun game provides a good level of challenge, without being too frustrating to complete.

Children are given a small crossword board, without questions, but with all vowels in place. Their job is to work out where the consonants fit on the board.

Letter Blocks - This one will keep everyone on their toes! It works on the same sort of premise as the game Boggle, mixed in with a bit of Tetris/Candy Crush.

You need to find words of three letters or more, where each letter is adjacent (including diagonally) to the next. You can't use the same letter twice, but click on each in turn, then double click the last letter and those blocks disappear.

More letters keep appearing from the top and the aim is not to let any column get to the top of the screen.
