


Literacy

In drawing club this week we watched an episode of 'Willo the Wisp'. The children wrote about a character and the setting. They took the story on an adventure, thinking about what trick they could play on Evil Edna and what Evil Edna might turn them into! We learnt vocabulary such as peaceful, fearless, teeny weeny, airbourne, scorched, transform, dawdle and loop the loop.

Understanding the World


This week we have been looking at rainforest habitat's. We have found out that there are different layers such as the canopy, understory and forest floor. We know that different animals live within these layers.
