- ✓ This week's **attendance** for EYFS and Key Stage 1 was 94% and for Key Stage 2 it was 94.5%.
- ✓ Thank you to our Year 6 pupils and staff who have been working really hard to make some changes
  to our Library. The library is now open again and It's lovely to see the children exploring this
  revamped space.
- ✓ Year 6 pupils sat the statutory SATs tests. The children have worked incredibly hard in the build up to SATs and they were definitely prepared and ready! We are really proud of their attitude and we look forward to sharing the results in the end of year reports
