Literacy

Our focus story this week was A Dark, Dark Tale. We thought what might be in hiding in the box at the end of the story and ideas ranged from rabbits to trains. In drawing club we drew one of the characters and then later in the week we thought about another character that might be hiding in the house. Ideas included bats, spiders and cats, with the odd cow and pig! New vocabulary included; velvety, important, pestering, immediately, glum, properly, furious and desperately. In phonics this week we have been recapping the sounds. We will continue to consolidate our blending and segmenting skills.

At home you could try:

- Reading the words attached and spotting sounds when out and about.
- Using lego, building blocks or paper squares to make different arrangements for 3, 4 and 5 e.g for 3 this could be 2 square on top of each other and one at the side. Are there any other arrangements?
- Practicing forming the letters shapes c, a, o, remembering the anticlockwise direction.
- Practising play lines and songs

We used the powder paints to create our own paint. We also explored what colours we could make with the primary colours: red, blue, yellow and white.



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






Start in the clouds- over the top and all the way round
